Our Wild Food allows you to reconnect with nature and find sustainably harvested food.

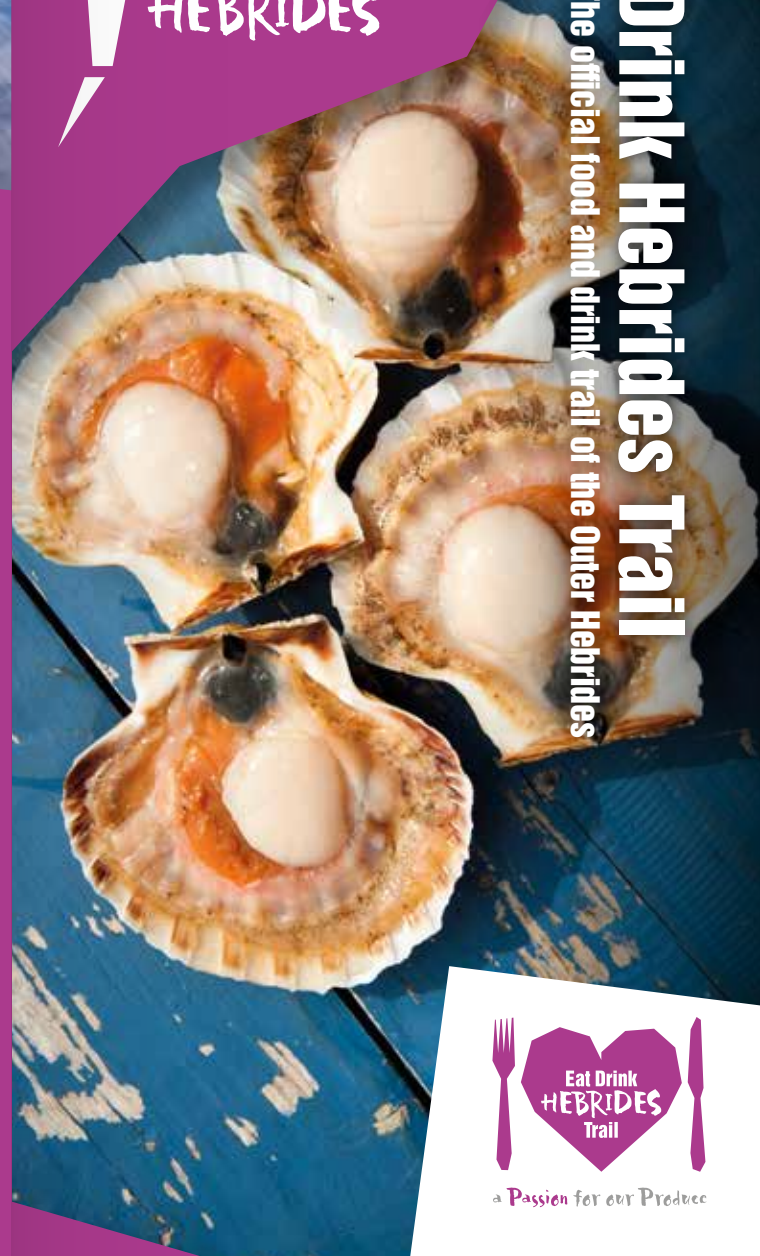

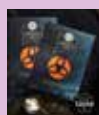

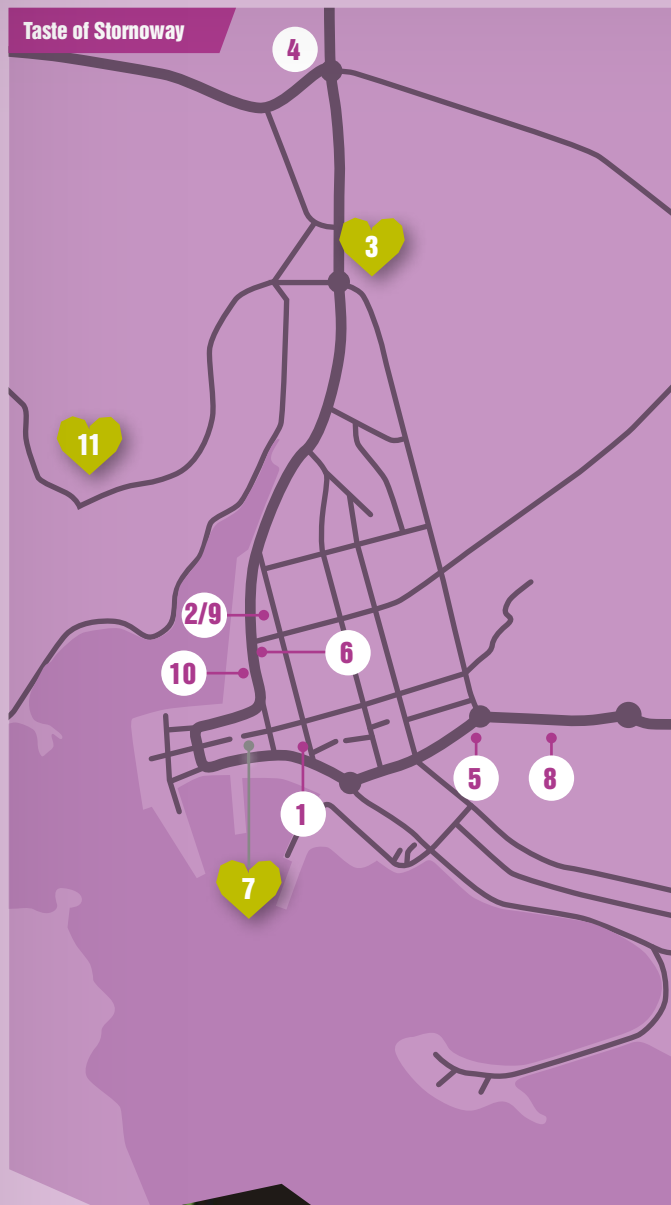
